Presentation: CSO Road Map to prevent violent extremism in Tunisia

February 1st 2021 - From 10h to 12h - Online Seminar

This Seminar is an initiative of the Tunisian Observatory to Prevent Violent Extremism (OPEV) and the Tunisian National Commission to Counter and Prevent Terrorism (CNLCT).

The goal of this seminar is to present a Roadmap of recommendations of the Tunisian civil society for the prevention of all forms of Violent Extremism. This Roadmap has been elaborated through a three years “bottom-up” process including an extensive field survey in six governorates that has been possible thanks to the support of the European Union, the AECID, and the ACCD.

This activity also aims to contribute to the debate around the revision of the National Strategy of the CNLCT of the Tunisian state, scheduled for the year 2021. By offering a structured and plural vision conceived by committed civil society on this theme, we hope to make a positive and relevant contribution.

The methodology of elaboration of the Roadmap has included a field survey in the Governorate of Tunis, Ariana, Kef, Kasserine, Medenine and Tataouine.

A total of 2,400 people answered to the field survey, including 49.9% women, 11.4% young people under 20 and 49% young people under 29. All responses were analyzed and grouped together to facilitate their analysis.

SWOT analysis suggested for each governorate and presented to the main representatives of local institutions and civil society actors to collect key proposals to prevent violent extremism.

Finally, the Roadmap is the result of a two-session seminar with CSO, academics, and practitioners to identify good practices and innovative proposals.
